## DESCRIPTION:

Kachemak Bay State Park is looking for a field supervisor for a trail project that includes trail corridor clearing, tread reconstruction and trail realignments. This is a field position, working and hiking outdoors in all types of weather. Must have a strong work ethic; ability to work with minimal supervision; and ability to work/live with others in remote settings in a safe manner. Must have knowledge of remote field operations in bear country; sustainable trail construction and/or trail maintenance principles; chainsaw and brushcutter operation and maintenance; and safe use and maintenance of trail tools. Will have to lift and hike up to 50 lbs. over difficult terrain. Knowledge of Leave No Trace ethics. Wilderness first-aid/CPR needed.
